Log In

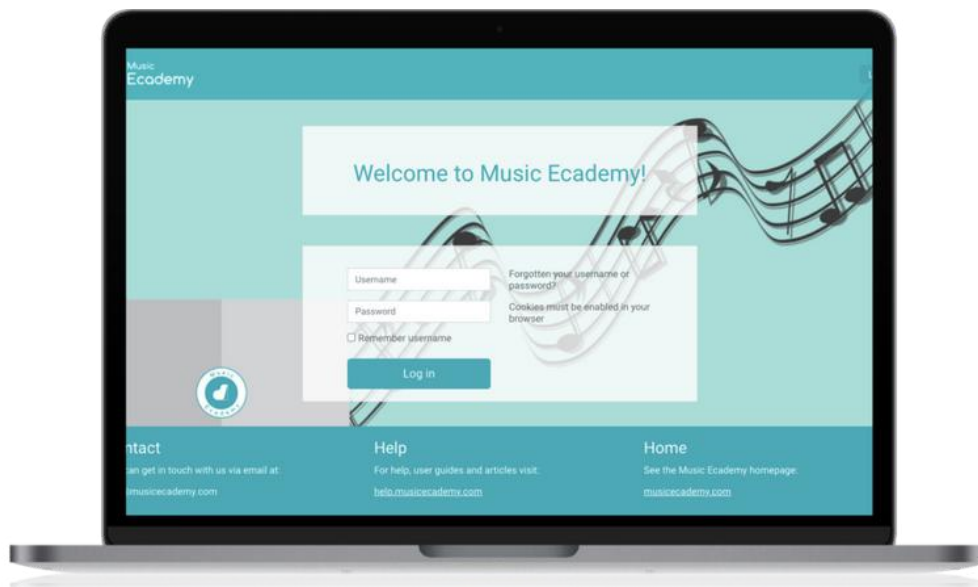
To get started firstly head to www.musicacademy.com and click on the 'Login' button at the top right of the screen.

You can log in using your username and password. We will either have sent you your username and password in an email, or if you are signed up through a school your teacher will have given you your details.



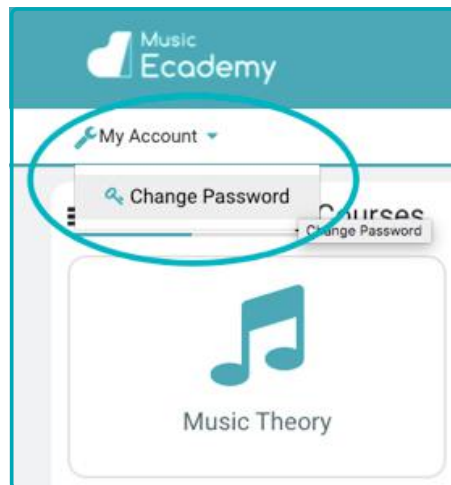
EDITING PROFILE

You can change your password from the drop down menu at the top left of the dashboard labelled 'My Account'.

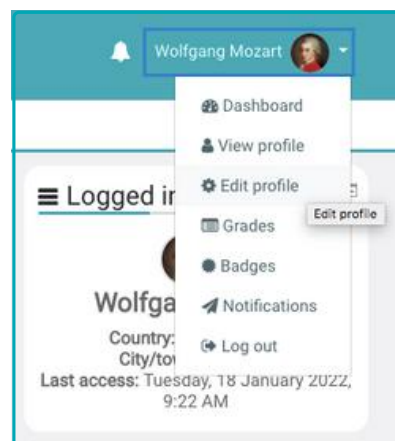
We recommend that you change your password when you first log in.

From the edit profile section you can change details such as your name and email address. You can also add other details, for example your Country or City, and you can even add a picture of your favourite musician or character!




STUDENT DASHBOARD

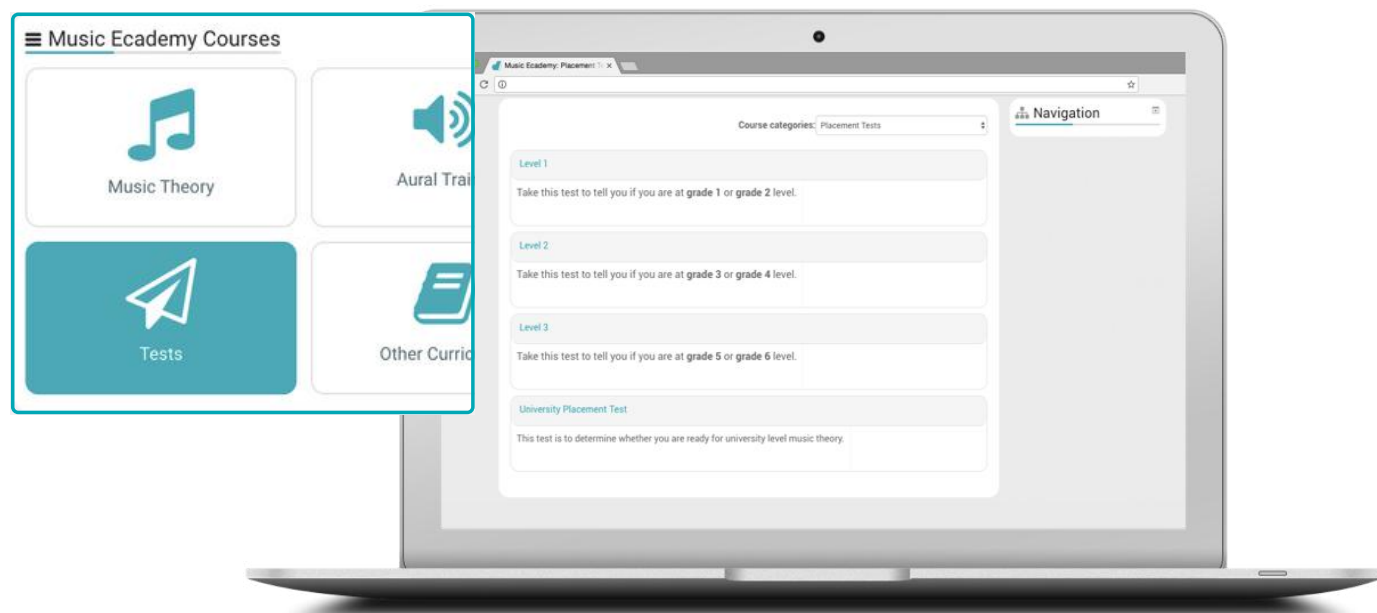
Placement Tests

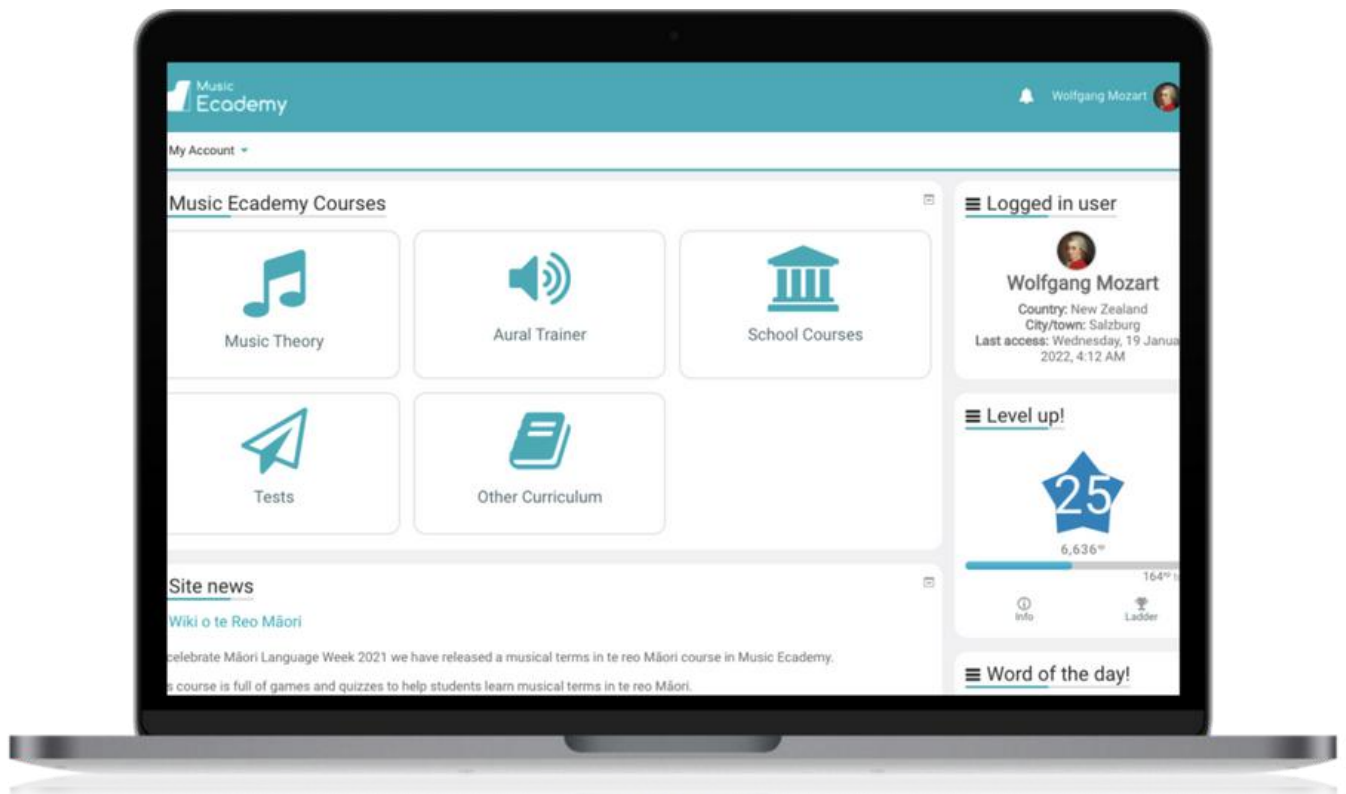

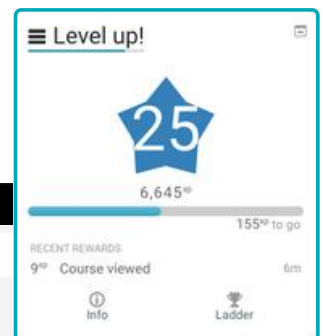


Working Through the Grades

The grades are broken down into bite-sized topics for you to work through.

Each topic contains lessons followed by quizzes so that you are continuously quizzed on what you have learnt.

You need to get a minimum grade in order to pass the quizzes. You can read the lessons and take the quizzes as many times as you want!

At the end of each grade there is a final test which you need to pass to complete the grade.


LESSONS

▶ Lessons

Lessons are laid out in an easy to understand manner, with diagrams, audio and images.

At the end of the lesson there is a quiz question to make sure you have read the material, before you can move on.

You can repeat the lessons as many times as you like.


QUIZZES




Games

Some courses also include games to offer additional practice.

These include shooting games, board games, memory games, and flashcard games, the latter are particularly good for young learners.

The 3 beginner music theory grades (beginner levels 1 - 3) are specifically built for younger learners, and contain the games to make the material more manageable.

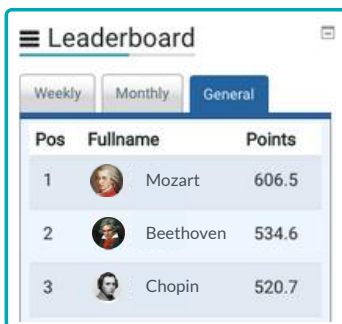
▶ Gamification Features

On all of the course dash-boards you will find the gamification features. These are designed to keep you engaged and motivated and to have fun whilst learning!



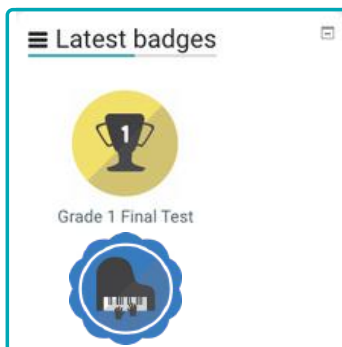
LEVEL UP

LATEST BADGES

This displays your latest badges. Badges are awarded for passing a certain number of quizzes or lessons, achieving high marks, passing grades, final tests and half way quizzes.



PROGRESS BAR

This shows you your progress within the course. Blue is not yet completed and green is completed. If you hover over the bar you can see the topic names and icons to show you if you have passed or failed.

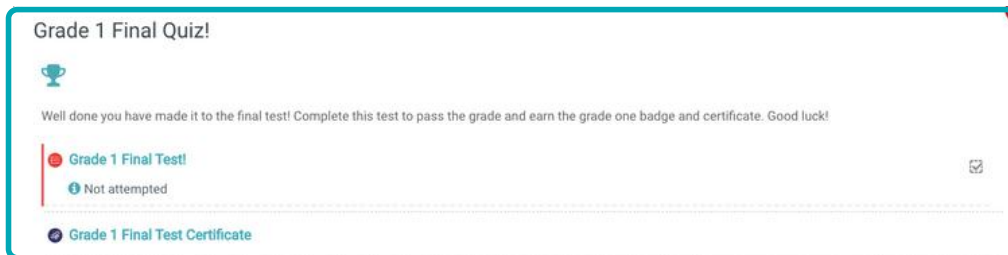
CERTIFICATES

▶ Course Overview

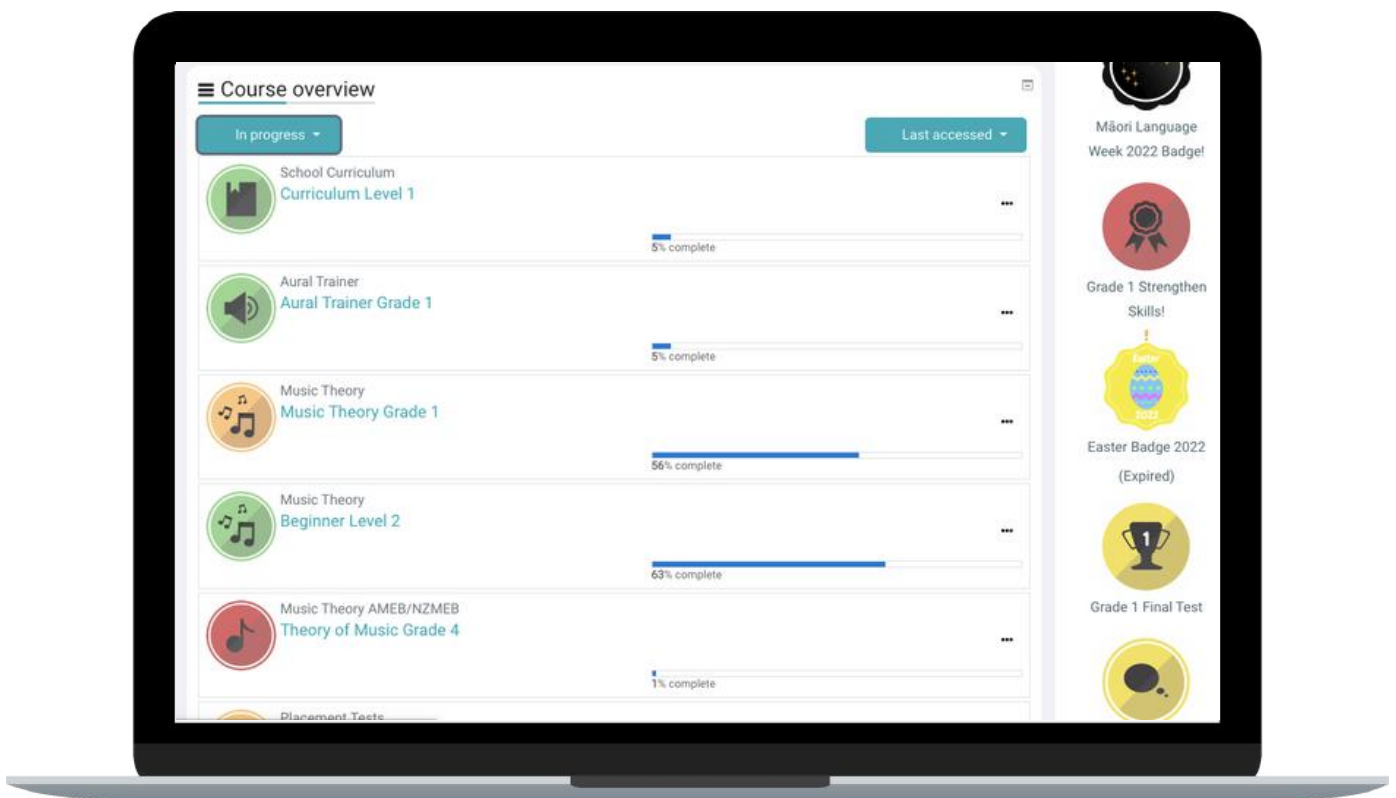
You can get an overview of what you have been working on and how much you have completed from the 'Course Overview' section on the Music Academy dashboard.

Here you will see a list of the courses with progress bars.

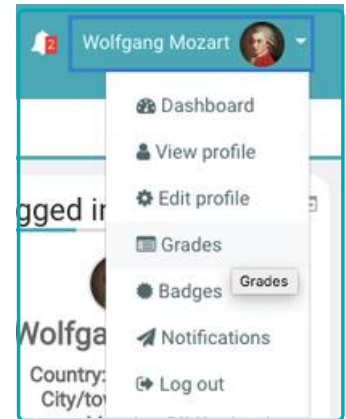
Use the drop-down menus to sort by course name or latest accessed.

You can also sort by courses that are in progress, or that you have completed in the past.



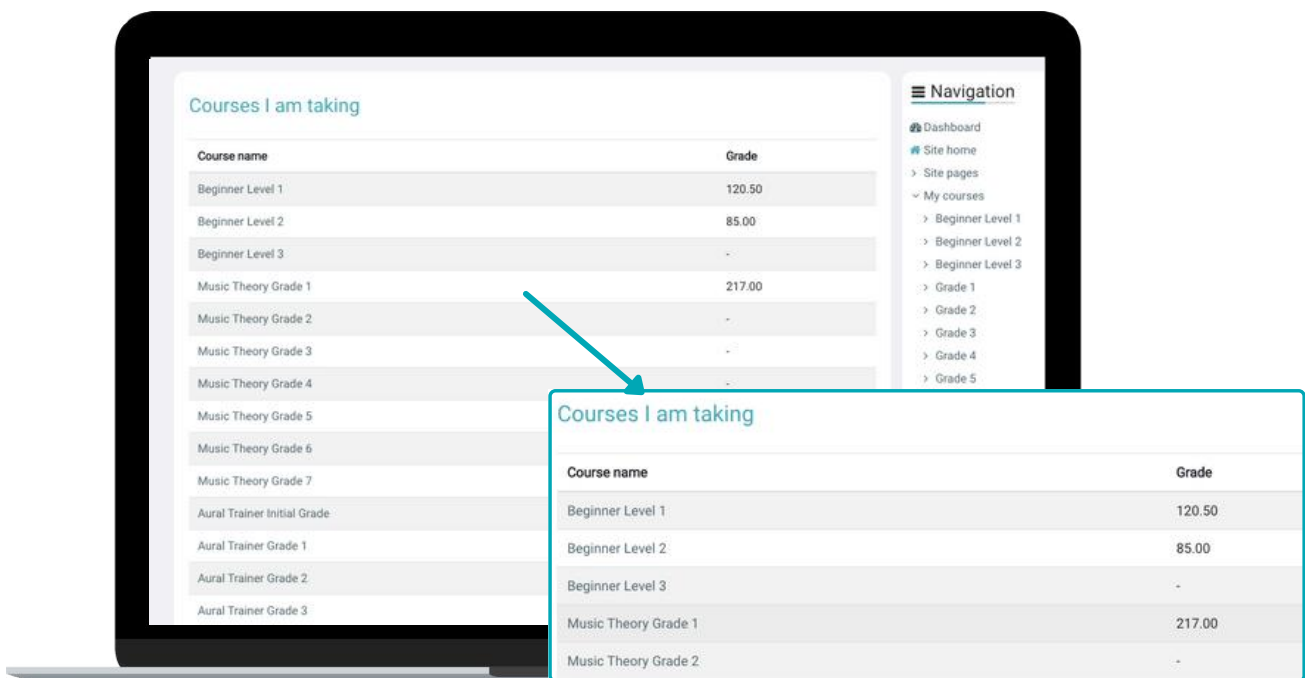
TRACKING PROGRESS GRADES

- ▶ **Grades**
Locate the drop-down menu next to your name and click on 'Grades'.
- ▶ **Courses I am Taking**
Here you will see a list of your courses.



If the course has a number next to it, it means you have started completing activities within that course.

If there is a dash, no activities have been completed in that course.



- ▶ **Detailed User Report**
Click on a course to be taken to a detailed user report for that course (page 15)

Tip: Open each course in a new tab

Try opening each course you wish to look at in a new tab. This way you can see the grades of each course next to each another and get an overview of your students' progress across the site.


▶ User Report

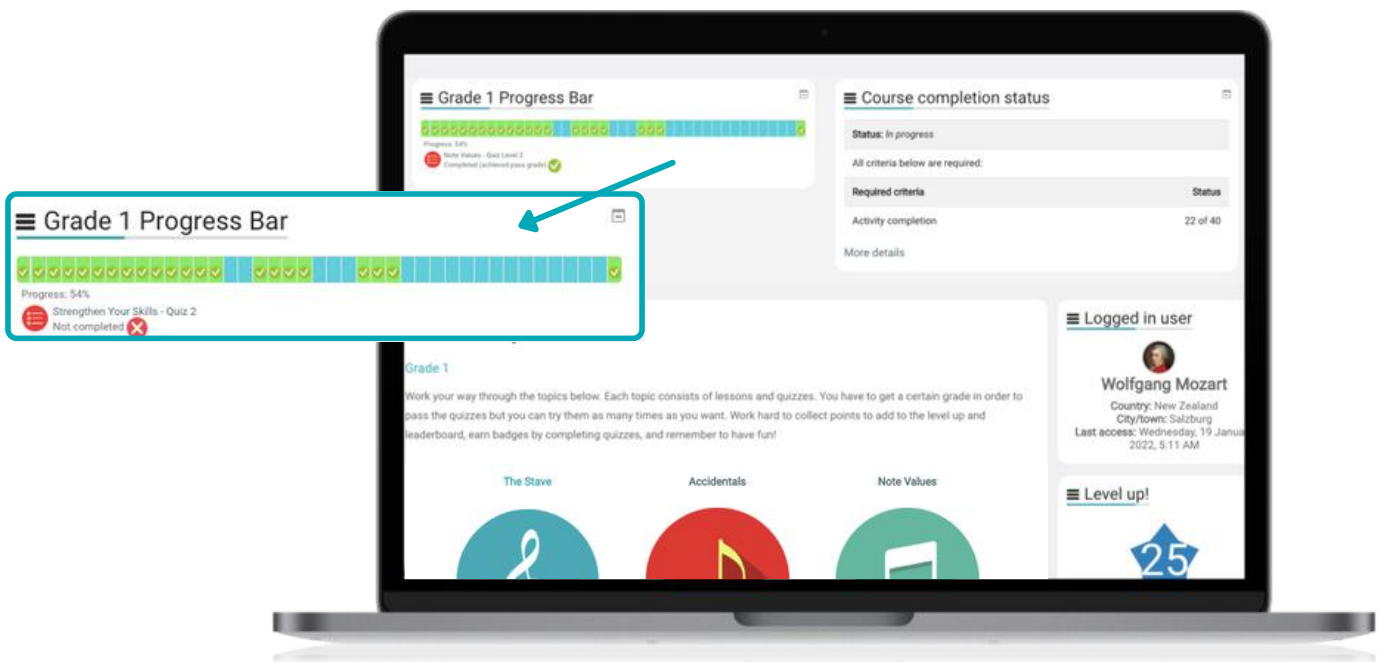
Progress Bar

Blue means the topic is not yet completed

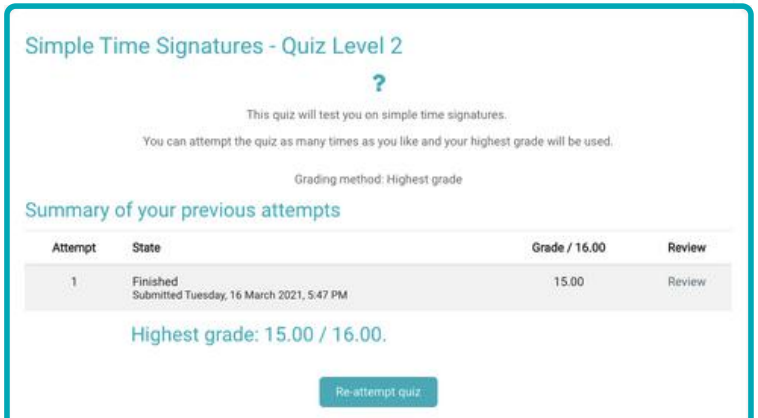
If you hover over the bar you can see the topic names and icons to show you if you have passed or failed.

Here you can see how many attempts you have made and the grades you achieved for each attempt.

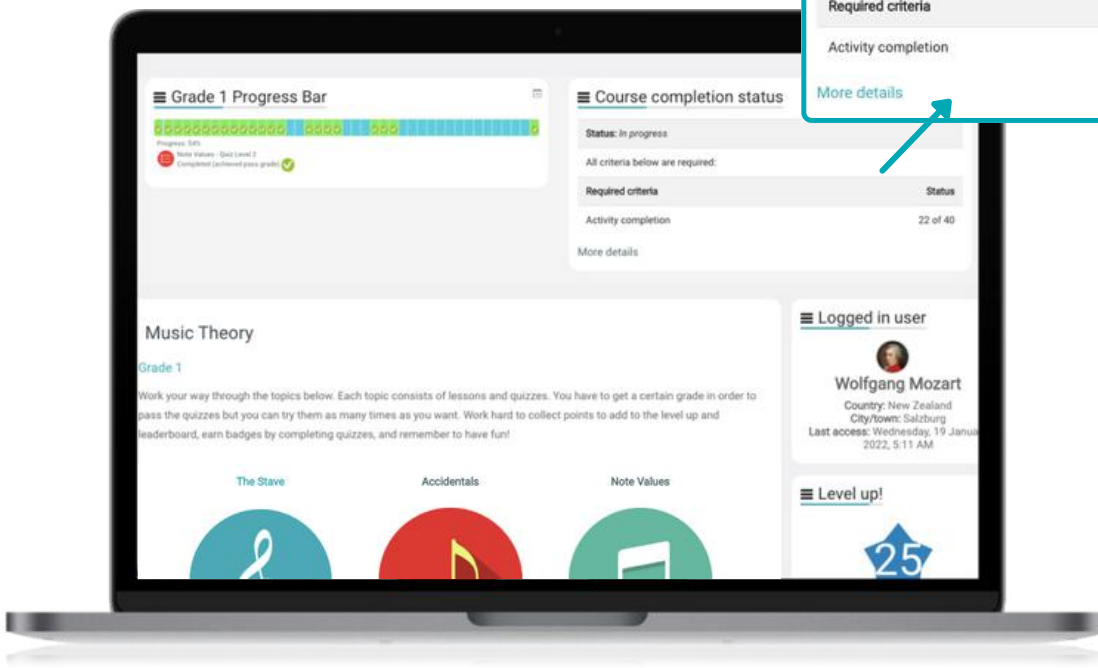


TRACKING PROGRESS COURSE COMPLETION




